Dear Student and Parents:

Listed below are the course selections for grade 10 students at Immaculata. As you can see, most of the courses are required by the Ministry of Education or the school (Religious Studies 10). It is important to keep the following in mind while making your choice. French 11, or any second language, is required for entrance to many university arts degree programmes. **There is no longer a general English 10 course.** In the 2019-20 school year the Ministry of Education broke down English 10 into 5 different “flavours” of English, each worth 2 credits. Students must take 4 credits of English 10 “flavours” to graduate. IRHS will be offering 2 flavours of English next year for a total of 4 credits of English studies in grade 10.
